

CITY OF LAWTON PSA, CITY OF LAWTON LAKES DIVISION

Citizens wishing to utilize golf carts in lake areas should note the following:

- Each golf cart requires a permit that can be obtained on line or purchased at License and Permits in City Hall or at the Lake Division. If purchased on line, an annual sticker will be mailed to the buyer. Annual sticker will be displayed on the left and right side of the golf cart below the seat.
- A yearly permit must be obtained \$75.
- The operator of the golf cart must be 14 years or older.
- Operators must obey all rules of the road.
- All golf carts must have two headlights and one taillight which are visible to vehicular traffic.
- GOLF CARTS ONLY are allowed on City of Lawton camp grounds. Any other ATV usage (motor bikes, 4-wheelers, side by sides) are strictly prohibited. Other ATV's may ride at the ATV track located off of Highway 277 between Porter Hill and Elgin, Oklahoma.

GOLF CART RULES AND REGULATIONS

The operator of the golf cart must be age fourteen (14) or older.

The operator of the golf cart shall:

- 1. Obey all speed all speed limits and comply with the rules of the road.
- 2. Yield the right of way to pedestrians and human powered devices at all times.
- D. The propulsion system has not been modified to allow the golf cart to exceed the manufacturer's recommended maximum design speed of the golf cart.
- E. All golf carts must have, at a minimum, two headlights and one taillight, which are visible to vehicular traffic.
- F. For purposes of this section, golf carts shall mean such motorized device as used at a golf course to transport people and golf clubs.
- G. The operation of golf carts is prohibited in the primitive camping area known as The Ponds, located on the eastside of Lake Lawtonka, except on the roadway serving the area.

SIDE BY SIDE REGULATIONS

Only a tagged and registered as a motor vehicle side by side can be at the Lakes. Once tagged and registered as a motor vehicle, ALL the laws that apply to cars and trucks will now apply to that side by side.

- 1. They must be tagged.
- 2. The operator must be a licensed driver at least 16 years of age.
- 3. Insurance and registration will be required to operate the vehicle.
- 4. The side by sides must stay on the improved road surfaces, including the highway. They will not be allowed to use the golf cart trails along the highway.
- 5. Operating the vehicle in a reckless manner and speeding will subject the operator to motor vehicle citations. Reckless driving is an arrestable offense and the side by side will be subject to impound.
- 6. Driving Under the Influence (DUI), Driving While Intoxicated (DWI), and Actual Physical Control (APC) are applicable to a side by side when they become registered as a motor vehicle and those offences will be as adamantly enforced in and around the lake properties as they are within the City of Lawton.
