Lawton Public Library Fiscal Year 2013: At A Glance

The mission of the Lawton Public Library is to provide opportunities to engage in life-long learning. The two library locations serve all of Comanche County. The libraries are open a total of 85 hours per week (60 hours at the Main Library and 25 hours at the Branch Library). Twenty-three staff members answered 25,719 reference questions last year and helped people check out 124,544 books and other items. People walked through the library doors approximately 243,900 times last year.
