Standards for Admissions

- Applicants must make a commitment to attend **all** sessions (1-2 emergency absences may be granted) and agree to terms/conditions of program.
- Applicants must be at least 18 years old and must be able to provide their own transportation.
- Participants must be a resident of Lawton, Oklahoma, a business owner in Lawton, or employed full-time in Lawton.
- Applications are taken on a first-come, first-served basis. The primary form of communication from City officials to class participants will be via email.
- The Citizens' Academy is a learning and informational program. Acceptable conduct and attire standards will be maintained by participants to assure each session is a positive experience.

Participants will:

- Meet City Council members, department heads and staff.
- Learn how decisions are made, how city funds are allocated and how departments operate.
- Enjoy comprehensive overviews of departments and programs and services.
- Discover the current status and future plans for Lawton's development, traffic, growth management, recreation, the environment and other topics.
- Participate in lively discussions, role-playing and other fun interactive activities.
- Tour and view city facilities, receive t-shirts and educational materials.
- Learn how to best navigate the official City website.
- Become an informed, involved citizen.
