

# RECREATIONAL PERMITS

Citizens **MUST** have State of Oklahoma licenses before obtaining City hunting, fishing, and boating permits.

## **Cost of Permits**

- Annual Individual fishing permit \$15.00
  - 5 year individual fishing permit \$60.00\*
  - Lifetime individual fishing permit \$180.00\*
- Annual Trotline permit in addition to fishing permit \$20.00
- Annual Jug line and bank pole permit in addition to fishing permit \$25.00
- Annual hunting permit \$ 25.00 (includes deer, small game & feral hogs)
- 5 year individual hunting permit \$100.00\*
  - Lifetime individual hunting permit \$300.00\*

## **Combination Fishing and Hunting Permits**

- Combination fishing and hunting 5 year \$160.00\*
- Combination fishing and hunting lifetime \$400.00\*

**\*5 year, combo and lifetime permits are to be obtained at the City of Lawton Lakes Division or the City of Lawton License and Permits offices only. These may be obtained during normal business hours Monday - Friday. Lakes Division: 7 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. License and Permits: 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.**

## **Fishing and Hunting Permit/Fee Exceptions**

1. Legal Residents under 16
2. Legal residents 64 or older providing such resident has in possession a senior citizen's fishing license issued by the state
3. City of Lawton retirees and their spouses
4. Disability 60% or more with proof of disability

## **Boating & Recreational Vehicles**

- Annual Boating \$35.00
- 3 day vessel permit \$15.00
- Golf Carts \$75.00 (must have a golf cart serial number before you can purchase a permit)
- Annual ATV \$75.00

# RECREATIONAL PERMITS (contd.)

Canoes, kayaks, paddle boats or paddle boards do not require a boating permit.

**Special Tournament event permit, nonprofit organizations up to 75 vessels, 3 days \$100.00.**

The special tournament permit must be filled out at the City of Lawton - Lakes Division at 23510 State Highway 58, Lawton OK 73507 Monday thru Friday 7 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. and no less than 2 weeks prior to the event. **Permits are good for both Lake Lawtonka and Lake Ellsworth**

Annual Fishing/Hunting permits expire on the one-year anniversary of the purchase date. Boating and golf cart permits expire on the last day of the year purchased.

## CITY PROPERTY ASSEMBLY PERMITS

If you are planning to hold an event on City property—including all City parks, ballpark tournaments, outdoor events near City buildings, or in any street area—you must first obtain a permit from the Parks and Recreation Department. Permits can be obtained at the Owens Multipurpose Center, located at 1405 SW 11th Street, Lawton. Visit the front desk, where an administrative assistant will guide you through the necessary steps to secure a permit for your event.

Event permits are required for any gathering of twenty-five (25) or more people using a street, alley, public way, park, or any property owned or managed by the City. Events that typically require a permit include festivals, walk/run competitions, parades, street fairs, and military recognition ceremonies.

Assembly permits must be submitted at least two (2) hours before the gathering. These permits require information such as the location, streets or parks impacted, date, and approximate timeframe.

Please note: When submitting a permit packet for park pavilion or area rental, the permit must be submitted at least 30 days before the event, per City policy. Fees may apply, depending on the activities and City services required. A detailed site map of your event must be provided to assist in the planning process. For safety and liability reasons, some events may require a Certificate of Liability Insurance.
