

PUBLIC NOTICE OF FILING AN APPLICATION

FOR A RENEWAL DISCHARGE PERMIT

The City of Lawton, located at 212 SW 9th Street Lawton, OK, has filed a Tier II application on 8/29/2024 to renew a discharge permit for the municipal wastewater from the Medicine Park Water Treatment Plant located at 82 East Lake Drive Medicine Park, OK or the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, Township 3N, Range 12W. The discharge point is located at Lat: 34° 44' 06", Long: 98° 30' 10" W, to Medicine Creek, tributary of East Cache Creek, tributary of the Red River. The permit, if issued, would establish effluent limitations of the discharge. The purpose of this notice is to meet the requirements of OAC 252:4-7-13(c).
