


SOULFUL STORY: TULSA: THE FIRE & THE FORGOTTEN

For example, they will be able see a triangle shape in the letter "A" & the circular shape of the letter "Q"! To get babies & toddlers more familiar with different shapes, try a scavenger hunt around the house. Look for different shapes & point them out in familiar objects, like the square sides of a picture frame, or the round shape of a dinner plate.
