#### **By Appointment**

From December 2, 2020 to February 13, 2020, Library staff helped 2,709 people by appointment (2,372 appointments at the Main Library and 337 appointments at the Branch Library). This is while library staff answered phone calls and ran

books out to customers via curbside service.



#### Library Cards

September is Library Sign up month but customers got cards throughout the year. Customers can now sign up for library cards without coming into the library. We issued 385 library cards via online signup and 2,578 cards overall for the year.

#### Taxes

The tax volunteers did 1,099 tax returns and brought over \$1,000,000 back to our community. Despite all the challenges, it was another successful year!
