



- If you could change anything about yourself, what would it be?
- What is the scariest thing you have ever experienced?
- Have you ever played a musical instrument?
- What is your favorite family recipe or tradition?
- Did you have any pets growing up?
- Have you ever met someone famous?
- Who were your grandparents?
- What is the longest trip you've ever made and where?
- Have you ever been in the news or received a special award or prize?
- What accomplishment are you most proud of?
