ADULTISH CRAFTS GRAB & GO: GIANT PAPER FLOWER

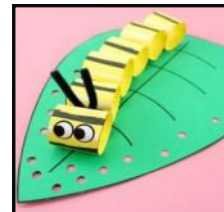
Starting Monday, March 15, while supplies last

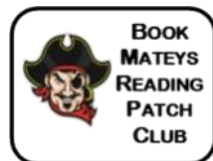

The goal is for you to read 1,000 BOOKS with your child from birth until kindergarten.



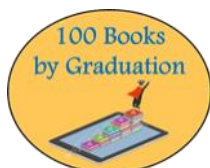
Self-paced reading program for kids from ages 0-12 years. Earn patches for reading!
