
HOLIDAY GRAB & GO FAMILY BAGS

COVID's IMPACT


The Lawton Public Library was closed for 2 months due to

While the library was not open to the public, your library



staff fielded over **3,500** phone calls & checked out **2,269** books. During the same time, people checked out **8,870** e-books & other digital material.



The library implemented Curbside Pickup, online library card registration, improved library card renewal, and hosted its first of many virtual classes.

Library employees also moved books and shelving around to make the space more user friendly!
