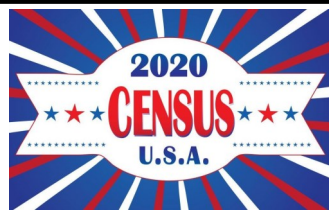
FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY

Chautauqua will return in 2021. The theme is 20th Century Visionaries.



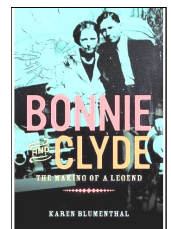
